CAIRO- ANCIENT WONDERS


Day 1: Arrival in Cairo, Egypt - Gateway to Ancient Wonders

Day 13: Bethlehem and Ein Karem - Birthplaces of Faith


- Travel to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus:

 - Reflect at the Church of St. John the Baptist, commemorating his birth.


Day 14: Mount of Olives and Mount Zion - Sacred Reflection
